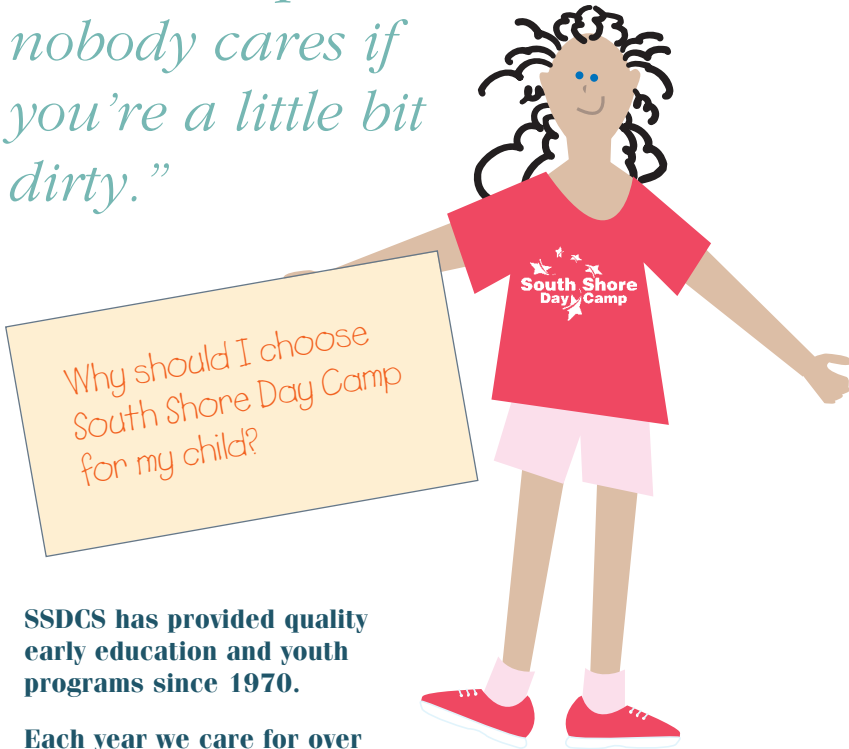

- Multiple age appropriate activities including: arts and crafts, athletics, swimming instruction, free swim, games, dance, boating, karate, nature, archery and a ropes course for older children.

- 1:8 staff to child ratio (1:5 for five and six year olds). Staff are teachers, child care workers, and college students.

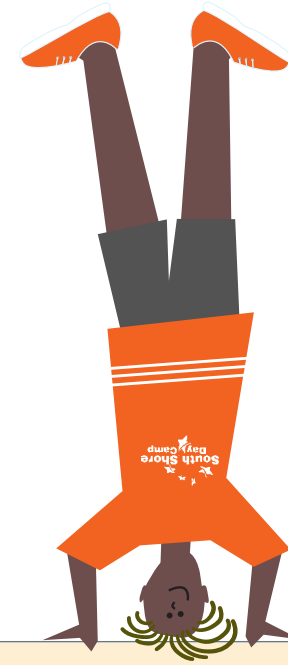


Bus stops are conveniently located

- Pickups range from 7:30 TO 8:00AM with drop-offs between 4:30 and 5:15PM.
- Transportation is provided in passenger vans and school busses monitored by camp staff.

How do I register my child for camp?

- Complete our registration form and mail with a two week deposit.
- Availability of weeks, groups, transportation, and extended hours are based on first come-first serve.
- A two week deposit which is applied to your last two weeks of camp is required. Mastercard and Visa are accepted.
- **We will not refund for weeks chosen but not used except for a medical reason, supported by a physician’s note.**
- You may choose any weeks (a four week minimum is required).

This camp must comply with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (105 CMR 430.000), and be licensed by the Westwood Board of Health. Information on these regulations can be obtained at (617) 983-6761.
